The 2004 RM Reserve “Nelwood” Petit Verdot displays an attractive rich crimson red colour; lifted perfumed plum and cherry fruit with nicely integrated vanilla oak. Exhibiting a rich and complex palate with characteristic cherry flavours and soft but distinct tannins lingering.

This is a super premium wine for the discerning wine lover that will develop for several years.



Nelwood Estate

Located 20 miles East of Renmark on the South Australian border is Nelwood Estate. It is owned by a viticultural family with a strong record of consistently producing grapes of the highest quality over four generations.

The vineyards have significant plantings of Shiraz, Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot that are produced to the very high quality needed to create the style of wine export markets demand.

Proprietor Richard Dolan believes that wine is a unique expression of the land and the people who care for it - that wine, in essence, is grown.

The RED MUD Story

RED MUD is the Aboriginal name for the bend of the Murray River on which the town of Renmark in South Australia was established.

RED MUD depicts the red cliffs along the Murray River and the rich red limestone soils that has proved ideal for producing quality wines.

Richard and Margaret have used their perception of Australian Aboriginal rock art, the world's longest continuing art tradition, to portray their wine.

The art is a tradition that is not only decorative, but provides a pictorial record of the longest surviving culture on Earth A journey in time.
